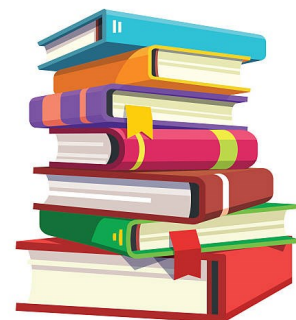

Roy Ringrose has visited K/6B this week!

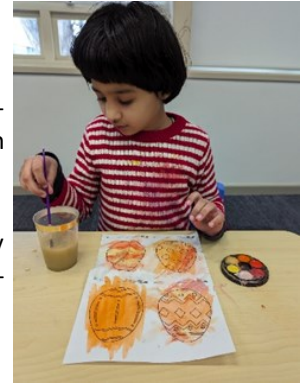


An Eggscellent Week in K/6B!
